2020 Faction Carnival

Our Pearsall sport season is culminating in our Faction Carnival on Friday 18th September. As communicated earlier, due to the current COVID-19 situation restrictions will be in place in regards to spectators (please refer to previous Connect notice for details). **Parents are not permitted to enter the school grounds during the day.** Students will not be able to be taken by parents after their events. If parents wish to sign out their child, they must do so through the front office.

Toilets: Parents and younger siblings are only permitted to use the disabled and student toilets in Block 4. These can only be accessed through the gate near the basketball courts. These toilets will be off limits to Pearsall students during the day.

- Parents are not permitted on school grounds but are welcome to make their way to the marked Parent Spectator area on the northern side of the oval.
- Entry from Ashbrook Avenue. All spectators must remain in the allocated area and are not permitted to approach students during the carnival.

Phase 4 of the WA COVID-19 roadmap continues

Based on the latest health advice, Phase 4 of the WA COVID-19 roadmap has been extended until Friday 23rd October. The new tentative start date for Phase 5 will now be Saturday 24th October. A final decision on whether Phase 5 can proceed on this date, or if it can be brought forward, will be made in October. Schools are to continue to follow the Phase 4 Operating Guidelines until further notice.

So while we are in Phase 4 it is important we are ready for any new wave of COVID-19 by maintaining our hygiene, physical and social distancing measures. This will put us in the best position to combat a second wave, should one eventuate. Re-introducing these measures after the commencement of a second wave would be too late to prevent it widely spreading, so maintenance is vital. So we ask everyone, while on the school grounds to:

- Maintain hand hygiene
- Ensure 1.5m social distancing
- Use the 2 square metres rule to calculate how many people can fit in a space
- Get a COVID-9 test if you have any symptom's and then self-isolate until you get the all clear
