COVID-19 Updates

With the ever evolving nature of COVID-19, we will continue to keep you updated with changes to operation at the school as soon as they come to hand. Please ensure that you are checking Connect messages. Thank you to all parents and carers who have started the year positively, with mask wearing, social distancing regulations and not entering classrooms.

GATES

The school gates structure will allow for all students to enter with parents and caregivers in the mornings and in the afternoon. Starting in Week 3, this Monday, students in Years 1 to 6 will enter the school on their own. PrePrimary parents can enter gates with students until the end of week five. Kindergarten parents can continue entering the gates for all of term one. In Term 2 all students will be greeted at the gates by staff and student leaders.

Student Medication

Parents of students requesting medication to be administered during school hours must complete an "Administration of Medication" form available at the school office. Approval is required from the Principle before any medications are administered by staff. **Under no circumstances are students permitted to "self-medicate" during the school day.**

Connect

Student Safety

This alerts all staff and children that correct procedures have been followed.

On-entry Assessment



Attendance

Regular attendance at school is fundamental to your child's social and academic learning. In Semester 2 2020, we had 80% of our students (505 students) who attended greater than 90% of the time, (compared to 79 %, 508 students in 2020). We also had 16% of students or 101 students who attended between 80%-90% "At Risk- Indicated", compared to 16% (103 students) in 2020. As Parents, or legal guardians of an enrolled child, you are responsible under the School Education Act 1999 to ensure the attendance of your child at school every day. It is important to assist your child's achievement's and learning by making regular school attendance a priority in your child's life. The Department of Education's Student Attendance Policy requires parents/guardians to provide an acceptable explanation to the school principle for any absence of their children. Principles must authorise all absences. The Act defines health, religious and cultural observances as reasonable cause for a school absence and the absence would be authorised by the principle. Families who are taking family holidays during school term should also write to the principle with the length of intended absence. Family holidays during term time cannot be authorised by the principle and will be recorded as an unauthorised absence.

Mobile Phones

A departmental policy has come into force this year, prohibiting all Primary School children from carrying a mobile phone on them, or in their bag, during school hours. Under our school policy, parents who require their child to carry a mobile phone to and from school must leave phones with the Teacher.

Hats

For health reasons, students are required to wear a sun safe hat (broad brim, bucket or legionnaire style) for breaks and outdoor activities. Students without hats will be restricted to playing in the undercover area or on play equipment under a permanent shade structure.
